SUBJECT: Full Accreditation for the Automated Technical Order Management System
(ATOMS - D359)

1. According to the provisions of AFPD 33-2, *Information Protection*; AFI 33-202, *Computer Security*; and DoDI 5200.40, *Department of Defense Information Technology Security Certification and Accreditation Process (DITSCAP)*; and DoD 8510.1-M, *Department of Defense Information Technology Security Certification and Accreditation Process (DITSCAP) Application Manual*, I hereby grant a Full Accreditation for the Automated Technical Order Management System (ATOMS - D359). This full accreditation is based on my review of the Certification Team's analysis documented in the System Security Authorization Agreement (SSAA) for ATOMS - D359.
2. This Full Accreditation is based on the system/data factors identified and analysis results documented in the SSAA. Any change to those factors may lead to future disapproval for system operation. Therefore, it is incumbent upon the Program Manager and the Information Systems Security Officer (ISSO) to ensure any change in those factors is analyzed to determine the impact on system security. I certify that an appropriate level-of-protection exist.
3. The HIGH vulnerability as identified in Attachment Q1 of the ATOMS SSAA, is, and will be perpetually mitigated by individual base Communications Groups in the form of Microsoft Windows Security Patches and third party Virus Detection Software. Any change to those factors may lead to future disapproval for system operation.
4. This signed Full Accreditation Letter, Certification Letter, the DAA Representative endorsement will be maintained in the SSAA as required.
